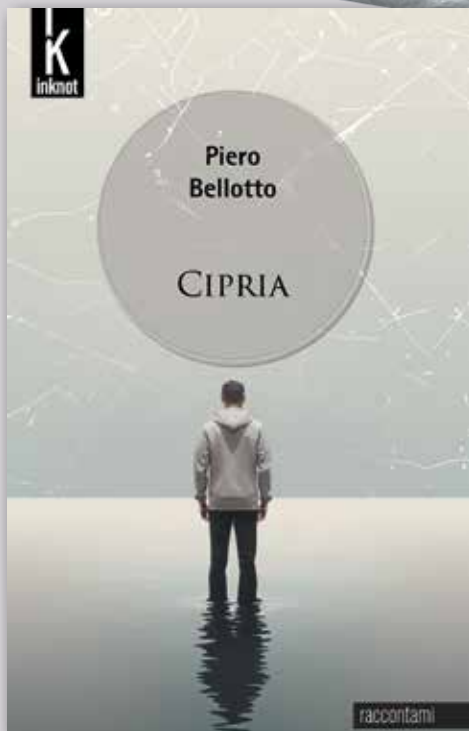

Piero is a former dancer whose career dreams have dissolved against the gray reality of precarious work. Returning home from a dance class, he learns of the death of his mother, Lula.

Loved and hated, repulsive and symbiotic, his mother is an enigma that Piero longs to unravel by disentangling the intricate web of omissions behind which she has taken refuge.

An umbilical cord never truly severed, a relationship complicated by the presence of Mamau, the dark and angry alter ego who shares with Lula that sense of perpetual unhappiness on which Piero feeds.

We see him as a child already, playing with his demons to shape himself, dodging gossip and bullying tied to his homosexuality; then just past adolescence, when he leaves the provinces to move to Milan; at the end of a stormy relationship with Sally; when he stumbles along an obstacle course made of bodies and addictions, in an attempt to give direction to his life.
